The students helped to dig and fill a Barefoot Sensory Path around the perimeter of the garden, filling with stones, bark chip and log slices

WALKWAY



Student worked together to help build raised planters from reclaimed pallets. Using tools under strict supervision they built, painted, lined and planted

WOOD WORK



Students created flower beds to represent the seasons, each planted to flower at those times of year, providing stimulus winter through summer

SEASONS



Students helped design and select items for the garden that would enable all 5 senses to be stimulated; sight, smell, taste, touch and sound

GREEN INFLUENCERS

Working closely under the guidance of teacher, learning support and the Green Mentor, students focussed their project on creating a brand new **Sensory Garden** to allow year round access to nature and outside learning opportunities



DESIGN

With great support and supervision, all students designed and helped to build all elements of the sensory garden



PLANTING

Students planted seeds, bulbs and maturing plants into the ground and flower beds to add colour, scent and support wildlife
